Shri Jai Karan Sharma's success sparked the imagination of a generation of progressive Indian entrepreneurs. He was a business statesman and visionary who introduced, what is now called Integrated Logistics solutions with multi-modal transportation, warehousing, packaging and just-in-time solutions, and way back in the 1980s. He had a knack for visualising the future economic scenario, which helped him take the most daring decision relating to fleet expansion and asset acquisition which resulted in sectoral growth and huge employment generation.

Speaking on the occasion **Shri Sandeep Anand, CEO, Alden Global Value Advisors and Member Logistics Committee FICCI** said, "We are happy to honour and recognise Shri Jai Karan Sharma, Founder Chetak Group with the title of **"The Logistics Man of India".** The entire logistics community unanimously decided that he is the most deserving person to receive this award for establishing the logistics sector as an important contributor to the nation's growth."
